President's Report

- Relief School Update Draft 2 parent workgroup meeting on 4/18 with parent meeting @ AK 4/19
 @ 6:30pm. All feedback is welcomed to Claire Schultz, CMS. Unfortunately, 1st draft doesn't give AKHS much relief. Recommendation to contact our congressman regarding the future rezoning on the new middle school.
- Waiting on Teacher Appreciation date to be confirmed. Pay4schoolstuff website will be opened up to collect donations for this event.
- Proctors urgently needed for AP exams. Sign-up genius already sent out.
- Email sent out today regarding next year PTSO positions so they can be elected in the May meeting. Urgently need a Treasurer position.

Treasurer's Report

- Capital Campaign is at 73% of the goal but we are making progress.
- PTSO membership budget line is at 111% of budget.
- Expenses remain in line with budget with the exception of Hospitality. The custodian
 holiday dinner is shown in the Staff Meetings/Other category. However this unplanned
 expense was funded by the December special collection. End result is that our
 expenses remain in line with the budget. I foresee underspend in Benevolences,
 Winterfest/Springfest, BTS Packet Expenses, Shredding and Traffic Officers. I expect
 we will run over in Hospitality and Educational Support Miscellaneous due to teacher
 retirement gifts.
- CMS will pay for the Traffic Officers base rate. We only have to pay the differential.
- Starting to build the carryover we need for next year (have ~\$7K in carryover funds if we spend our entire 2022-2023 budget). We need that to be about \$15K by the end of the

- year so we are halfway there Scholarship Committee need to look at when to push out applications.
- Deposit from Harris Teeter for \$2,500 has been made. Shout out to our Corporate Links lead for this.
- Another shout out to our Fundraising Committee who have raised 10% of the Capital Campaign goal and 14% of total funds raised.
